

YFC Executive Leadership Forum



Purpose

The Executive Leadership Forum is a best in class, cohort style experience for select high potential leaders in a familial environment integrating spiritual formation with executive competencies development for a culture that expects, produces, and deploys spiritually maturing, highly effective leaders for the Kingdom of God, advancing the mission of YFC.

Content

Presentations include lecture, case studies, small groups and experiential learning led by a handpicked faculty of authors, ministry leaders, professors, business owners and select YFC leaders.

- Practice waiting on God and examining oneself in order to "be conformed to the image of Christ for the sake of others." (An on-site spiritual director will attend all seven sessions.)
- Assess individual personalities and motivations to more fully understand oneself
- Identify own decision-making, conflict management and supervisory styles in order to lead others more effectively
- Essential leadership competencies include the following:

Build successful teams - Supervise staff constructively - Use time management and evaluation tools effectively - Discover & integrate culture and values - Practice break-through thinking methods - Compose compelling marketing pieces - Explore the cost of leadership

Participants - By invitation only.

Hi-potential veteran staff (5+ years) with three distinguishing attributes:

- 1. Ability**- To be effective in more responsible and senior roles
 - Character/Christ-Centered Leadership
 - Intelligence
- 2. Aspiration**- To rise to senior roles
- 3. Engagement**- To commit to the organization and remain in challenging roles

Commitment

- Seven three- and/or four-day sessions over a period of two years
- Reading assignments
- Monthly one-hour processing call with small groups

Cost \$7,500 plus travel (payments over three fiscal years)
