

KINGDOM INSPIRED DIVERSITY (SMALL GROUP)

LESSON 1: ALL THE COLORS OF THE RAINBOW

Objective: Students will recognize that diversity adds value and is God's idea



MATERIALS: Coloring pages, crayons

ACTIVITY:

Give just one color to each student and one coloring page. Give them a couple of minutes to start coloring. Ignore the complaints if any while they color. Remind them they can only color with one color crayon,

Ask: What is the problem with coloring with only one color crayon?

What would the world be like if humans were all the same?

God has made us all unique and different. How is that better than being all the same?

Discuss the beauty in diversity. Give them new coloring pages and allow them to color with as many colors as they would like. Post them up on a wall or the door and have everyone admire the one color vs multicolor pages.
