PHYSICAL EXPECTATIONS	<ul> <li>Participate in all program activities as much as you are able (excuses would include pregnancy, broken bones, health conditions, etc.)</li> <li>Ensure kids get their medications at meals &amp; evenings</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Participate in all program activities as much as you are able</li> <li>Participate in free time activities with cabin</li> <li>Step in as leader/facilitator when Cabin Leader has to leave the group</li> </ul>
SPIRITUAL EXPECTATIONS	<ul> <li>Lead cabin time</li> <li>Schedule 1 on 1's with each young person</li> <li>Explain the Gospel &amp; person of Jesus Christ</li> <li>Exhibits 3 Story</li> <li>Have people praying for you throughout the week</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Participate in cabin time</li> <li>Has an existing relationship with Jesus they feel comfortable sharing about</li> <li>As a spiritual leader remember that small group times are for youth. Leader meetings are for leaders. You can still experience breakthrough, just be aware of time and place</li> </ul>
WHAT IS NOT YOUR JOB	<ul> <li>Pictures: There is a camp photographer, just because you have your phone doesn't mean you should be on it and have to take pictures for the campers</li> <li>Discipline: use Head Leaders!!</li> </ul>	Engagement: Experience camp as a cabin leader, not a camper
