

#### Camp/Trip Leaders:

We've created this template to highlight some key areas of training for Ministry Leaders for your camps/trips this summer. We strongly urge you to consider scheduling a full day with all your ministry leaders that will be attending your camp/trip, approximately 1 month before your camp/trip. You may also find it beneficial to partner up with a nearby YFC chapter and do this together.

We recommend that you do the morning training sessions as they are listed below, and then feel free to customize the rest of the training as you see fit. We've selected several topics that ministry leaders have referenced as areas they would like to receive more training. However, you know your group of leaders better than we do, so please customize this to meet the training needs of YOUR leaders! #### 8:00-8:15 - Welcome & Thank You

- Express how grateful you are for them committing to going on your camp/trip and serving kids in this way
- Give them a small gift if you have space in your budget! Nothing says "thank you" like a well thought out gift. Perhaps something they can use during your camp/trip: a nice water bottle or coffee thermos, a journal, a t-shirt or other clothing item, etc. At a very minimum, provide snacks and drinks throughout the day.
- Give them an overview of the day so they know what to expect.

## 8:15-9:30 - 3Story® Refresher

- We call this a refresher because we assume every leader has done some 3Story<sup>®</sup> training. If you have any leaders who have not yet completed a 3Story<sup>®</sup> Training session, please make that happen before this particular camp/trip training day.   - As a pre-assignment to do BEFORE this training, leaders should watch <u>this</u> <u>video</u> of Myron Bernard presenting information about trauma informed care.
    (Or if you would rather use time during this training day to watch the video together, the video is 36 minutes long just adjust your schedule accordingly.)
